You should already have this covered. If not, MinisterNow! is just a click away.

Contact Local Magistrate

Each county has different rules for weddings in their municipality. It is always good to check, to make sure that you are aligned in accordance to their system.

A simple call to the County Clerk's office in the city that the wedding will be held should always be your first step.

No worries, the next page has a list of the things you should ask when you call.



The following phrases are helpful when speaking with the county clerk:

- What agency or department issues marriage licenses in county and how may I contact them?
- I am a minister. What do I need to do to be recognized in this county for weddings?
- Do I or the couple file the marriage license with you, once the wedding is done, and I sign it?
- Do you require that I originate a certificate of marriage for the couple?

Once you are acknowledged in your area, you are ready for the wedding. The clerk will also let you know whether you or the couple should file the finalized marriage certificate with the county.

What Should I Charge?



Prices vary from minister to minister, and officiant to officiant. Many do the service for free, charge only for travel, or for a donation.

Yet, others list a cost for the service, rehearsal, travel and for special keepsake marriage documents. What you charge should be based upon the cost of your time, gas and availability.

Depending on the size of the wedding, fees can range from \$100 for a simple service to \$500 or more for a custom ceremony.

Meeting with the couple beforehand for pre-marital counseling could also be a fee.

As a guide, many of our ministers create a package with a set number of premarital counseling sessions (usually 3), charge \$50 per session and include the \$150 in the fee for the ceremony.

Marriage License

This is the document that comes from you and tells the local magistrate that the couple has been joined in marriage.

Here is a tried and true list of beautiful and low-cost certificates from Amazon. Make sure to order in ample time for the ceremony. Make sure to have the completed certificate at the ceremony if the couple is going to file it. Even if you do the filing to the local magistrate, a beautiful certificate makes an amazing keepsake for the happy couple.

Pray, Peace and Pics

Make sure to get some pics of your big day. This will build your album of ministry memories. Make sure to share them with us, to help build the faith of the next new wedding officiant!
